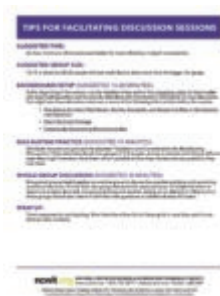


Interrupting Bias in Academic Settings
