PRIZES

Up to three National Winners receive a cash prize of \$2,500 and public recognition. Each Regional Affiliate Winner and Honorable Mention receives recognition, access to professional development funds, NCWIT resources, and an engraved award. Regional Affiliate Winners also receive a cash prize of \$250.
